Current Open Projects for Assignment Volunteers, by category

Community Education, Coordination & Assistance

- Present **Kindness Initiative** to Jewish professionals and community leaders
- Create a program to improve coordination and cooperation across all TKI service providers
- Implement "Helping Hands" program in each synagogue, school and community organization

Identification of Vulnerable Jewish Households

- Work with existing Jewish organizations (e.g. synagogues, schools, etc.) to identify affiliated households in-need
- Develop non-traditional communications campaign to reach unaffiliated households
- Create database to identify and track vulnerable Jewish households

Support-System Entry

- Develop a customized emergency-needs navigation program with JFS and 211
- Single source mapping to identify and access SPOs, gov't benefits and new programs

Information Development

- Develop map and database of Service Providers Organizations, government services, and new programs

Navigation Assistance

- Single address for government benefits sign-up
- Single source mapping to identify and access SPOs, gov't benefits and new programs
- **Nutrition/ Food Security**
- Distribute information on free and discounted food sources to vulnerable households, by location
- Develop matrix of meal delivery options throughout the county

Housing



- Manage and update inventory of available low-income housing options and details on access
- Solicit multi-family property owners for emergency housing units
- Develop “Virtual Village” for older Members
- Create home-sharing service to match Members to available housing
- Source out new low-income housing options

Employment

- Develop program to facilitate job placement, and identify open job positions in the community
- Review Member resumes, and offer constructive input
- Develop matrix of low-cost and free childcare options for employed or job-seeking
- Develop program to facilitate job placement, and identify open job positions in the community

Health/Wellness & Professional Services

- Develop matrix of low-cost & pro-bono professional services
 - Medical/Dental/Vision
 - Medications Assistance
 - Behavioral Health
 - Disability services
 - Domestic Violence Victim Support
 - Legal Services
 - Tax preparation & accounting Services
 - Financial Planning
 - Group activity programs/day care

Transportation

- Develop matrix of low-cost & pro-bono auto-repairs programs, by location
- Develop ride-share program for Members who are unable to drive for some reason
- Create subsidized car-leasing program for Members

Household basic goods

- Develop coordination plan w/ G'mach for solicitation of household goods and supplemental funding for Jewish Life Cycle Events (e.g. bris, bar/bat mitzvah, weddings, funerals, etc.)

- Identify potential seed-funding sources
- Lead development for special funds
 - Rent Relief Fund
 - “Adopt-a-family” Community Fund
 - Life cycle Events Subsidy Fund
 - Emergency Basic Needs Fund (transportation, medications, etc.)

- Project proposal development & grant writing
